From its inception in 2001 following the September 11 terror attacks, CTPAT remains a voluntary public-private sector partnership whereby members work with U.S. Customs and Border Protection to strengthen international supply chains and improve border security, by protecting the supply chain from criminal activities such as drug trafficking, terrorism, human smuggling, and illegal contraband.

Superchute has developed and maintains a multi-layered security program that is consistent with the CTPAT Minimum Security Criteria, and remains committed to protecting our organization and supply chain from any illicit activities.

Security is everyone's responsibility. All employees and business partners, including contractors, service providers, and visitors are required to comply with the CTPAT policies and procedures that are in place at the Superchute facility.
